



RECYCLE BOTTLE CAP PROGRAM

Wooden Cross will be participating in the “**Recycle Bottle Caps with Aveda**” Program. Often, these caps end up as litter or trash and migrate into our rivers and oceans. Birds and other marine creatures mistake them for food with tragic results. The magnitude of this pollution problem is devastating to our oceans and wildlife.

Caps included in this collection are any plastic “twist-on” caps with a threaded neck, sometimes noted with a 5 in the chasing arrows recycling symbol. Some examples are: *water, soda, milk, and other beverage bottles, laundry detergent bottles, shampoo/ conditioner bottles, flip top caps on tubes, food product bottles (such as ketchup and mayonnaise), laundry detergents and some jar lids such as peanut butter.* Excluded from collection are pharmaceutical lids and non-rigid lids or “snap fit” plastic caps such as yogurt lids, margarine, cottage cheese, and any metal caps.

Please do not include any pumps or sprayers. Unfortunately, too much of the wrong types of materials can contaminate the recycling process. A blue recycle bin labeled “Recycle Caps” will be placed in the Fellowship Hall next to the other recycle and compost bins. Please bring in your “twist-on” caps and deposit them into our new Recycle Cap bin.

Thank you for your help in continuing to green our congregation as we make our best efforts to care for God’s creation.
